Project Description: Ku-Maloob-Zaap is the most productive oil field in Mexico. Ku-Maloob-Zaap is made up of three relatively large fields Ku, Maloob and Zaap, which are located to the immediate northwest of the Cantarell field. Zaap-E, a WHP, was developed for the Zaap field in order to increase production.

Scope of Work: Our SOW included the engineering, procurement and construction (EPC) of the wellhead platform with a total weight of 6,800 tons. The breakdown of the weights is as follows: Topsides 1,600 tons, Jacket 2,100 tons, and Piles 3,100 tons. This is the second platform we have successfully delivered for the Zaap field.
